Rode Weather Report for August 2025

The following is a summary of the key readings on my Davis Vantage Vue weather station located in the middle of our back garden in Rode. I have put the readings in a table and shown the equivalent readings since mid-2020 when I installed the system.

August continued the warm and dry trend up to the last few days. Total rainfall for the month was only 22.6mm of which 17.4mm fell in the last 5 days. There were 22 days when I recorded no rain. Temperatures reached 30°C or higher on 4 days and the maximum of 36°C was reached on 12th of the month. So August continued the 2025 trend over the three summer months of higher than average temperatures and lower than average rainfall.

Back in 2022 the late Mike Cooper gave the Frome average rainfall for August since the start of the millennium of 82mm. As you can see from the table above, in 2022 I recorded an average maximum of 27°C, the highest I measured for August over the last 6 years.

Today the Met Office has confirmed that Summer 2025 was officially the warmest summer on record for the UK. This year, 2022 and 2018 are now three of the 5 warmest UK summers on record.
