Rode Weather Report for June 2025

The following is a summary of the key readings on my Davis Vantage Vue weather station located in the middle of our back garden in Rode. I have put the readings in a table and shown the equivalent readings since mid-2020 when I installed the system.

June has been a warm month though not especially dry. We had twice the rainfall compared with last year. The maximum temperature on the last day of the month of 33°C was higher than any of the last 5 years. We also had three days in a row with a maximum temperature of 32°C (20,21,22).

Total rain for June was 40.6mm. The maximum 24 hour rain figure was only 9.2mm, much lower than any of the previous 4 years. In June 2022 Mike Cooper gave the Frome 23 year average for the month as 62.6mm.

Nationwide the Met Office reported that England had its warmest June on record. It goes on to say: "This follows a <u>record-breaking spring</u>, which was officially the warmest and sunniest spring on record for the UK. June continued that trend, marked by two heatwaves and some high temperatures to see off the month."
